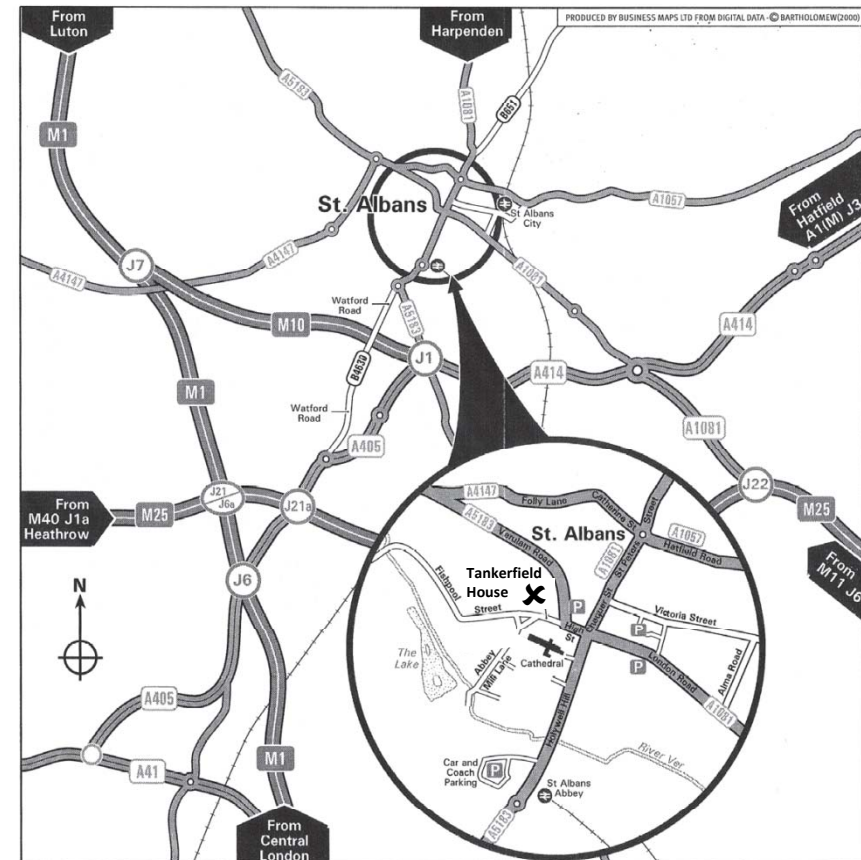
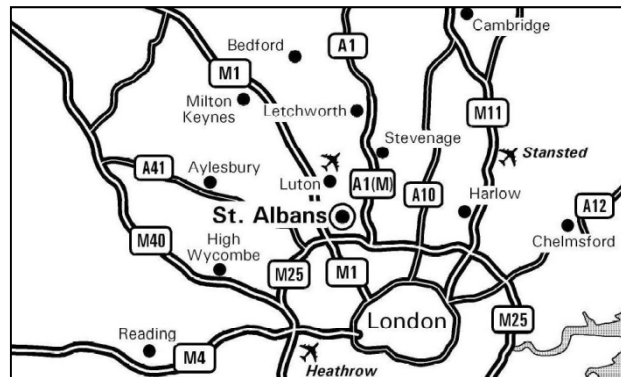
General travel instructions

By Car: Close to the M1 (Junctions 6 – 10), A1(M) (Junctions 3 & 4), and M25 (Junctions 21a & 22), St Albans is easily accessible from all parts of the UK.

By Rail: London's St Pancras International Station is only 20 minutes away from St Albans City Station on the First Capital Connect line and there are frequent services throughout the day and night. The rail service also connects St Albans to Luton, London Luton airport and Bedford in the north, and Gatwick airport and Brighton heading south. St Albans is also connected to Watford via the Abbey Line. Trains from Watford Junction serve the North London Line and the West Coast mainline.

By Bus and Coach: St Albans is well connected on the local bus network with services from North London, Watford, Hemel Hempstead, Hatfield, Welwyn Garden City, Harpenden, Luton and Watford. The Green Line 724 service links St Albans with Heathrow airport and West London, Harlow and Essex.

By Air: Both London Luton and Gatwick airports are directly linked to St Albans by rail. London Heathrow and Stansted airports are also easily accessible.



The best way to approach by car

We are located on the corner of Spicer Street (which is a one-way system) and George street. The best way to approach by car is as follows:

- 1) Drive along Verulam Road
- 2) Turn into Lower Dagnall Street. This is opposite a bar called Mokoko, and next to a Barbers shop
- 3) Take the first left into Spicer Street
- 4) Tankerfield house is the last building on the right
